

# Samaj Vikas Sanstha

## Annual Report – 2021



I am very happy to present the annual report of Samaj Vikas Sanstha of year 2021. Samaj Vikas Sanstha has been working in the social sector for the last 25 years for public service, advocacy, training and for economic and social change. I would like to thank all members, donor organizations and individuals, beneficiaries, persons who helped to get project grants,

volunteers and staff of Samaj Vikas Sanstha for their continuous effort. Because of them Samaj Vikas Sanstha have made contribution to society for socio-economic reformation.

The annual report is as follows:

### 1. Vatsalya Seva Kendra: -



The project started in 2006 and continues to this day. This service center is running for rehabilitation of orphans at Umarga in Osmanabad district of Maharashtra. This year organization is taking care of 3 destitute children, providing them education, health and training facilities. In addition, rations, clothes and food were distributed among the the poor and orphans. A total of **220** poor children were provided with rations, meals and clothes in the lockdown due to Covid-19. These children are mainly from poor families, beggars.

## 2. E-learning project:



Under this project, computer training, English Speaking, Internet handling training was provided to the youths who have passed 12th or University degree at Govandi, Mumbai through the e-learning project.

Achievement:

Hundred (100) youth got benefitted from this courses and now they are working independently in various companies.

The Smile Foundation New Delhi helped to complete this training course.

## 3. Digital Marketing Training Program:

The digital Marketing training Project has been started on 15th January in Talegaon



Dabhade, Pune. Through this project, Samaj Vikas Sanstha have decided to train 135 youth men and women and make them financially independent by providing assistance for getting job in various companies. First batch of 45 youth already started and training has been completed successfully.

Achievement: -

45 youths ready to get jobs by imparting digital marketing training.

## 4. Mission Education Project:



To bring the children into the mainstream of education who are economically backward and are dropped out of school due to poor economic condition of family, the organization has been working for the last four years for

the development of such diverse children's education, health through tutitions, happiness classes, skill training, communication skills, leadership skills training programs.

This project is working for the development of 60 children in Deonar area of Mumbai.

In the current year, the study rooms and libraries are running every night for the educational development of these children. The children were also trained for leadership development through sports songs, stories and aptitude classes. Children's health was checked twice a year.

Achievement: -

A total of fifty children can speak confidently today, express their thoughts, they have achieved excellence in Mathematics and English. This is the achievement of this project.

### 5. Mask making Project:

Under this project 35000 masks were made and given to Dilasa self help group.



The masks were distributed to the police in Pune district through Dilasa self help group.

Achievement: -

Dilasa self help group helped the traffic police in Pune district by distributing masks to protect 35000 policemen from Covid-19 pandemic.

### 6. Covid-19 Relief Program:

In the lockdown of Covid-19 pandemic, people like daily wage workers, construction workers, beggars, elderly people were starving due to unemployment. These people started migrating to their native places by walking. To stop the starvation of these people,



Samaj Vikas Sanstha with the help of Oxfam India, Smile Foundation, Lokhandwala Foundation and local friends distributed dry ration, masks, soaps, hand wash, sanitation kits, Sanitizers and ready to eat meals in Osmanabad, Pune, Nagpur and Mumbai to protect them from Covid-19 pandemic. A total 34500 families got benefitted from this Covid-19 relief program.

Achievement:

1.5 lakh people from 34500 families affected by the Covid epidemic were provided with rations to survive for at least 15 days without any worry. Their hunger stopped and the children got enough to eat. They were able to use a masks to protect themselves from pandemic. Organization helped them to live without any worry of starvation for atleast fifteen days in the hard times of pandemic.

### **7. Covid-19 Response Project:**

Under this project, one thousand (1000) women from economically weaker sections of the society living in slums in Govandi area of Mumbai were trained through tailoring



training, mask making training, bag making training, sanitizer making training for economic and social change. After the training, these neglected and last women were helped with various tools such as clothes, sewing machines, Xerox machines for earning money.

Achievement: -

One thousand women living in slums in Govandi area benefited from this training, out of which 11 women started their own small businesses, including Mask Sales Center, Pav Vada Sales Center, Vegetable Sales Center, Xerox centre.

At the same time, thirty five women applied to the government for help under various schemes of government for women empowerment programs. These women provided guidance about various schemes of government by Samaj Vikas Sanstha and helped them with application process to get benefit from these schemes.

### **8. Future work for Saavli Old Age Home:**

As there is small space available near farmers' training center of Samaj Vikas Sanstha, there was a meeting conducted and discussion happened to start a Saavli old age home at that place for the tremendous future of elderly people.

Achievement: -

Project proposals were sent to various aid agencies to raise funds for the construction.

### **9. Farmers Training Center:**

In Turori village of Umarga in Osmanabad district,

A model center for agricultural development has been set up at the place where the institute is located. A variety of fruit trees have been planted there and now they grew very big. A training center on how to do good farming is run in less space.

Achievement: -

This year it was completed by planting 250 saga trees. Now the fruit trees began to bear fruit. The center looks very beautiful. From this, various types of fruits like lemon, custard apple and mango are now available.

Farmers from the area come to this place for training and see small agricultural experiments that farmers are now doing in their fields.
